The Honorable Jason Rogers Williams was sworn in as District Attorney of Orleans Parish on January 11, 2021. He is a proud Tulane University Law School Alumni. After graduating law school, he started his own law practice focused on criminal defense, Jason Rogers Williams and Associates Law Firm. After winning a series of high profile criminal cases, the Louisiana Supreme Court appointed Jason to serve as a judge in the New Orleans' Criminal District Court. He was a councilmember for six years, four of which he served as Council President, before being elected District Attorney on a promise of sweeping justice reforms.
